Essays are reviewed by the Alternate Admissions Committee if the undergraduate application does not qualify for automatic admission to the University; leadership points may be considered for military experience included in the essay

Certificate of Eligibility

Military member will receive this letter by mail from the Dept of Veterans Affairs within 3-4 weeks of application

VA Form 22-1995 OR 5495 for Dependents

Request for change of program or place of training form is required for transfer students and for students that have changed their major

DD Form 214, member 4 copy

A copy of the discharge papers is mailed to the Dept of Veterans Affairs to establish eligibility for benefits following a period of active duty service. A copy is also needed for the veteran file.

Transcripts from all schools attended, including Military Transcript

Military transcripts will be evaluated by Admissions for transfer credit toward program, including military coursework and experience; must officially request the AARTS, Coast Guard, Community College of the Air Force, or SMART transcript. High school transcripts are required if the student has less than 30 transfer college credit hours.

SAT or ACT Test Scores

SAT or ACT test scores are used to determine admission for students with less than 30 college credit hours that transfer towards a program. Active duty members are able to take the tests through the Education Services Office (ESO) on base. For students that had not yet taken a national SAT or ACT test, Texas A&M University-Corpus Christi Academic Testing Office offers the ACT Residual Test.
